APPLICATION: For approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide Intrastate Interexchange Telecommunications Services in the State of Alabama.

REPORT AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed on or about June 4, 2010, Tower Cloud, Inc., a Delaware corporation, 9501 International Court, North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33716, seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide Intrastate Interexchange Telecommunications Services in the State of Alabama.

Pursuant to notice dated July 12, 2010, the application came on for hearing on August 11, 2010. No one intervened in the proceeding, but Commission staff participated in the hearing.

It appears from the record in this cause, and we find, that the public convenience and necessity requires the proposed service and the public interest will be best served by the proposed operations. In addition, it appears that the Applicant is qualified to conduct the operations proposed.

Accordingly, it appears that the Applicant should be granted a certificate authorizing the provision of Resold and Facilities-Based Interexchange Telecommunications Services which is consistent with the services similarly situated applicants have been authorized to provide.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is hereby issued to Tower Cloud, Inc., 9501 International Court, North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33716, authorizing operations as a provider of Resold and Facilities-Based Interexchange Telecommunications Services in the State of Alabama.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Applicant shall not commence the provision of Resold and Facilities-Based Interexchange Telecommunications Services in the State of Alabama until such time as the Applicant has submitted a tariff governing said service that has been approved by the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Applicant shall file annual reports consisting of audited financial statements and shall maintain adequate books of account and financial records in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and the rules and regulations promulgated by this Commission. Said books and records shall separate the telephone resale service from all other business in which Applicant may be engaged.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That any changes e.g., name, address, telephone number(s), contact personnel, or any other pertinent information concerning the Applicant shall be filed with this Commission by written transmittal letter within thirty (30) days from the time of change. Failure to comply will result in this Certificate becoming null and void and any and all other authority(s) granted under this docket number will hereby be immediately revoked.




